England vs Australia – Headingley, 2019 (Ashes)

Another **Test match that fans will never forget**. Chasing 359, England looked done and dusted at 286/9. Then came *Ben Stokes' miracle knock of 135 not out**, turning the game on its head with audacious strokeplay. With Jack Leach holding up the other end, Stokes pulled off one of the greatest comebacks in Ashes history.

ODI Cricket – The Format of Balance and Strategy

ODIs strike a fine balance between the traditional and modern. There's time to build an innings and enough urgency to keep fans on the edge of their seats.

England vs New Zealand – World Cup Final 2019

When we talk about the **most memorable matches in ODI cricket**, this game is right at the top. The 2019 ICC World Cup Final had everything—tension, drama, and a finish unlike any other.

Both teams scored **241 runs** in their innings. The match went into a **Super Over**, which again ended in a tie. England won the World Cup based on the boundary count rule—a finish that left fans stunned and debates alive for weeks. It was the first time England lifted the World Cup, and it came in the most dramatic fashion imaginable.

India vs Pakistan – Chennai, 1997

This was one of the **greatest ODIs ever played between India and Pakistan**. In a high-pressure chase of 327, India fell agonizingly short by just 35 runs, but it was **Saeed Anwar's magical 194** that stole the show. It remained the highest individual score in ODIs for years and is still remembered by fans of both sides.

T20 Cricket – The Format of Fireworks

T20 cricket is all about thrills, big hits, and fast-paced action. It's tailor-made for today's generation and has given rise to many **iconic T20 matches** that fans can't stop talking about.

India vs Pakistan – T20 World Cup Final 2007

Joginder Sharma's final over and Misbah-ul-Haq's failed scoop created one of the most epic finishes in cricket history. India won by 5 runs, claiming the first-ever T20 World Cup and starting a new era of cricket in the country.
