lakh for an ODI, and ₹3 lakh for a T20 International. These amounts can increase with performance bonuses and consistent selection.

IPL Contracts and Earnings

Siraj's IPL journey began in 2017 with Sunrisers Hyderabad. However, it was with **Royal**Challengers Bangalore (RCB) that he truly made a name for himself. For several seasons, he was retained by RCB for ₹7 crore per season. In a major turn of events during the IPL 2025 auction, Siraj was bought by **Gujarat Titans** for a whopping ₹12.25 crore, significantly boosting his annual income.

Over the years, Siraj's total IPL earnings have crossed the ₹40 crore mark, making him one of the highest-paid Indian pacers in the tournament's history.

Endorsements and Other Income

Siraj has also capitalized on his popularity with multiple **brand endorsements** in the fitness, sports, and lifestyle segments. Additionally, he was awarded an honorary **DSP** (**Deputy Superintendent of Police**) rank by the Telangana government, which comes with a government salary and perks.
