If selected, he would complement the spin duo of Ravichandran Ashwin and Axar Patel, providing India with a potent spin attack capable of challenging even the most resilient West Indies batsmen.

The fast-bowling lineup is expected to feature Jasprit Bumrah, Mohammed Shami, and Ishant Sharma, offering a balanced mix of pace, bounce, and experience. Considering the pitch conditions and West Indies' historical struggles against quality spin, many experts predict that India might give Kuldeep a chance, especially if the wicket shows signs of turning. His inclusion could tilt the balance in India's favor, giving the spinners more options to attack in tandem.
