Sophie Devine and Amelia Kerr are the frontrunners for New Zealand, both in sublime form. For Pakistan, Sidra Ameen is the one to watch — she's been their most consistent performer in the tournament.

Leading Wicket-Takers Prediction

Lea Tahuhu's pace and swing make her a dangerous weapon for New Zealand, while Nashra Sandhu's spin could be Pakistan's trump card on a slowing surface.

Player of the Match Forecast

Amelia Kerr stands out as the prime candidate for the Player of the Match award, thanks to her all-round brilliance and ability to turn games single-handedly.
