Gambhir Did It All Just To Prove A Point" – Fans React to India's Disappointing Batting Display in the 2nd T20I

India's batting collapse in the second T20I against Australia left fans frustrated and disappointed, as the Men in Blue failed to capitalize on a promising start and eventually fell short of expectations. Australia's disciplined bowling exposed India's lack of execution under pressure, leading to a four-wicket defeat that has reignited debates around team selection and strategy.

As the series heads toward the decider, Indian fans will hope the team regroups quickly. Whether Gambhir's strategic approach pays off in the long run remains to be seen — but for now, the spotlight is firmly on India's batting unit to deliver a strong comeback.
