GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES SUPPORTING THE LUBRICANTS EXPORT OF RUSSIA IN 2024

The National Project for International Cooperation and Export, launched by the Government Authorities of Russia, has enhanced the export infrastructure while reducing trade barriers. The Made in Russia Export Promotion Program has increased the visibility of the Russian lubricant's exporter in the global trade market.

The subsidized R&D and investment via the Industrial Development Fund have supported the production of low- and medium-tonnage chemical products. The state support for the Industrial Development Fund has introduced concessional loans for import-substitutional high-tech production.
