## GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES SUPPORTING THE LUBRICANTS EXPORT OF THE IVORY COAST IN 2024

The expansion and strengthening of petroleum and energy infrastructure have built the foundational logistics of the country for refining and exporting petroleum-derived products. The official push for industrialization and value-added transformation under the National Economic Agenda has generalized the support for the industrialization drive.

The emphasis on local transformation of extractive resources has strengthened the investment in lubricant production capacity. The creation and planned expansion of industrial zones and economic-industrial infrastructure have reduced the entry barriers for companies to produce export lubricants.
