

Textiles Exports of Nicaragua: Trade Trends and Updates of 2024

Textiles are materials made through processes such as knitting, crocheting, or weaving, using a variety of fabrics. This commodity is traded globally due to rising consumer demand and the specialization of different countries in fabric production. The involvement of skilled and semi-skilled labor workforce in the intensive textile production has maintained continuity of the global trade. [**Nicaragua Import Data**](#) says, the country in Central America bordered by Honduras and Costa Rica in the north and south direction has been a substantial contributor towards the global export of textiles due to its low labor cost and the tax exemptions for free-zone textile firms.



The ease of importing inputs and the strong link to global value chains have resulted in an export trade value of textiles worth 520 million US dollars in 2024. The flexible production models and the long-term export contracts have recorded a hike in the export revenue of textiles.

GOVERNMENT INITIATIVE SUPPORTING THE TEXTILES EXPORT OF NICARAGUA IN 2024

The free-zone regime has made the textiles export attractive by lowering the production cost with a proper boost to the export capacity. The support via the National Commission of Free Zones has strengthened the export capacity of textiles, while the approximate share of the zone-free companies has maintained the evolution of the production rate.

The Better Work Nicaragua program has improved the working conditions while maintaining the export competitiveness. The labor inspector training and institutional strengthening have strengthened the inspection capacity, with proper enhancement of the country's reputation as a reliable exporting hub. The social dialogue and tripartite commitments have introduced better social stability, with improved production consistency.
