2. Ineffective Bowling in Key Moments

SRH's bowling unit, usually known for its strength, failed to deliver under pressure. Even experienced bowlers couldn't contain RCB's aggressive batting lineup.

Players like Pat Cummins and Bhuvneshwar Kumar were expected to lead the attack, but inconsistency in line and length allowed RCB batters to score freely.

Particularly in the death overs, SRH conceded too many runs, which proved to be a decisive factor. Poor execution during these critical overs made it easier for RCB to chase or post a dominant total.

3. Missed Fielding Opportunities

Fielding often plays a crucial role in T20 matches, and SRH faltered in this department. Dropped catches and misfields gave RCB extra chances to build momentum.

In a format where every run counts, these small mistakes can turn the game completely. SRH's lack of sharpness in the field allowed RCB to maintain pressure and capitalize on scoring opportunities.
